DisAbility on stage

12–13 April 2019

Hosted by the Institute for the Performing Arts and Film (IPF), Zurich
University of the Arts in collaboration with the Accademia Teatro Dimitri SUPSI
in Verscio, the Swiss Association for Theatre Studies (SGTK) and with the
support of the Swiss Academy of Humanities and Social Sciences (SAGW).

Sowohl Theater als auch Tanz von und mit Darsteller*innen mit Behinderung sind sehr erfolgreich und geniessen eine grosse Aufmerksamkeit in der zeitgenössischen Theater- und Tanzszene der Schweiz – dies nicht erst, seit das Zürcher Theater HORA den Schweizer Grand Prix Theater / Hans-Reinhart-Ring 2016 gewann. Das Symposium beleuchtet den Beitrag Theater- und Tanzschaffender mit Behinderung in der Schweizer Theaterlandschaft mit dem Fokus auf die Arbeitsweisen, die Ausbildung sowie die Rezeption der inklusiven Theaterformen durch das Publikum. Das SNF-Forschungsprojekt ***DisAbility on Stage*** an der Zürcher Hochschule der Künste untersucht diese Aspekte im Dialog zwischen Theorie und Praxis sowie zwischen den verschiedenen Sprachregionen der Schweiz. Neben Vorträgen und künstlerischen Darbietungen werden Dialogformate entwickelt, die den Austausch zwischen Kunst und Wissenschaft sowie Teilnehmenden mit und ohne Behinderung fördern.

Die Veranstaltung ist öffentlich und richtet sich an ein interessiertes Fachpublikum (Theaterwissenschaftler*innen, Künstler*innen, Kulturveranstalter*innen, Fachpersonen aus dem Bereich Kulturelle Teilhabe, Dozierende und Studierende von Kunsthochschulen, Kulturvermittler*innen mit und ohne Behinderung usw.). Die Sprachen sind Deutsch, Italienisch, Englisch, klare Sprache und Gebärdensprache (falls gewünscht).

Theatre and Dance with and by disabled performers is currently very successful and attracts much attention in the contemporary Swiss theatre and dance scene – not only since the Zurich-based company Theater HORA received the most important theatre prize, the Swiss Grand Award for Theatre / Hans-Reinhart-Ring 2016. The symposium discusses the impact of disabled dance and theatre makers in Swiss theatre and dance, focusing on working practices, performer training, and audience responses. The Swiss National Science Foundation (SNSF) funded research project ***DisAbility on Stage*** at the Zurich University of the Arts (ZHdK) investigates these aspects by establishing a dialogue between theory and practice as well as between different language regions in Switzerland. Different formats – lectures, performative presentations, and workshops – are created to enable participation and to foster the exchange between academics and artists.

The event is open to the public and addresses theatre and dance professionals (theatre and dance studies scholars, artists, producers, lecturers and students from Arts Schools, theatre pedagogues with and without disabilities etc.). The languages of the symposium are German, English, Italian, easy language, as well as sign language (on request).

Il teatro e la danza di/con performer con disabilità stanno riscuotendo grande successo, attrattendo l'attenzione di un vasto pubblico nella scena del teatro e della danza svizzeri contemporanei – e questo non solo grazie al riconoscimento ricevuto dalla compagnia zurighese Theater HORA, che nel 2016 è stata insignita del più importante premio teatrale svizzero, il Gran Premio svizzero di teatro / Anello Hans Reinhart. Il simposio affronta l'impatto di danzatori e performer con disabilità nel contesto della danza e del teatro svizzeri, focalizzandosi sulle differenti pratiche di lavoro, sul training dei performer e sulla ricezione del pubblico. Il progetto di ricerca ***DisAbility on Stage***, finanziato dal Fondo Nazionale Svizzero (FNS) presso la Zürcher Hochschule der Künste (ZHdK), approfondisce questi aspetti, instaurando un dialogo fra teoria e pratica, e fra diverse regioni linguistiche della Svizzera. Il simposio si articola in diversi formati – conferenze, presentazioni performative, workshop – per consentire la partecipazione e favorire lo scambio fra accademici e artisti.

L'evento è aperto al pubblico e si rivolge a professionisti della danza e del teatro (ricercatori nell'ambito del teatro e della danza, studenti di accademie, artisti, organizzatori, pedagoghi, con o senza disabilità ecc.).
